We are pleased that your child has decided to participate in the Saugerties Skatepark Committee Skate-A-Thon. It is required that this Hold Harmless Release be completed by each skater's parent or legal guardian. The mandatory understanding concerning participation is listed in three parts as follows:

PART I.

1. You give your child, identified on top of this form, permission to participate at the Saugerties Skate-A-Thon on June 14, 2008.
You agree, on behalf of yourself, child, your assigns, executors, and heirs, to release, indemnify, and hold harmless The Town and Village of Saugerties, The Saugerties Skatepark Committee, and its officials, officers, agents, and employees from any and all liability, damage, claim of any nature arising out of or in any way related to your "child" participation at this Skate-A-Thon.
You state that you are aware of all the inherent dangers and risks involved in the Skate-A-Thon participation including but not limited to: bodily injury, sprains, fractures, dislocations, lacerations, concussions, skin disease, eye, head, neck, or back injuries, or death. Some specific risks include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Being hit or struck by sports equipment (skateboards, skates).
 - b. Being hit, struck, physically challenged or collision with other Skate board participants
 - c. Collision with park facilities (floor, structures, ground, obstacles).
2. You agree to be financially responsible for any accident or medical expenses incurred as a result of the Skate-A-Thon participation.
3. You understand that the terms of this agreement are legally binding and certify that you are signing this agreement of your own free will after carefully reading it.



PART 2. Medical Authorization

In the event of serious illness or injury, I authorize the Skate-A-Thon staff to transport (as deemed necessary) my child to a hospital emergency facility for treatment. All reasonable attempts to contact a parent or guardian will be made. I accept responsibility for all costs involved in the transport and treatment of my child. My hospital insurance carrier is:

PART 3. Rules and Regulations

1. Skating is restricted to skating areas.
2. All skaters must wear helmets. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
3. All skaters agree to act in an orderly, safe, and considerate manner while on the premises and in the skating area.
4. No “snaking”, Everyone is to wait their turn. Reckless or dangerous skaters will be requested to leave the skating area immediately.
5. All injuries, whether major to minor in nature, are to be reported to the staff immediately. In case of serious injury, do not move the injured person, and all skating shall cease.
6. Staff reserves the right to limit the number of participants in the Skate-A-thon. When skaters are waiting to enter, a time limit of 20 minutes per person will be imposed.
7. Use of profanity or abusive language is strictly prohibited and shall result in automatic expulsion from the Skate-A-Thon.
